In 1867 she removed to Fairfield , Iowa, where she lived seven years, making many dear friends and acquaintances. In 1874 she removed to Neosho Co., Kansas, where she lived up to the time of here(sic) death, and leaves a devoted husband and four boys, the youngest being about 15 years of age, to mourn her loss.
